Award will be based on the lowest conforming, responsible offer for the total price of the Base Year and Option Year (Items 1.0 and 2.0).

**PROPOSED PRICE SHALL NOT INCLUDE COSTS FOR INSURANCE PREMIUMS FOR OFFEROR OR SUBCONTRACTORS OF ANY TIER.**

**NOTICE:** This contract is covered by the Owner Controlled Wrap-up Insurance Program (OCWIP) and participation by the contractor and subcontractor is required. OCWIP coverage, as described in Contract Provision 20 is provided by the Authority at no cost to the contractor, except as described in 20.B which, if required, will be reimbursed to the contractor.

**COMMENCEMENT, PROSECUTION AND COMPLETION OF WORK:** The Contractor shall be required to (a) commence work under this contract within 10 calendar days after the date the Contractor receives Notice to Proceed; (b) prosecute the work diligently; and (c) complete all work ready for use not later than three hundred sixty five (365) days after Notice to Proceed. The time stated for completion shall include punch list and final cleanup of the premises.
