QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. Question: Are the restrooms on the public or secure side of the airport terminal? If public side is there a need for blast containment receptacles (trash cans) in the restroom areas?

Response: The bathrooms are on the secure and non secure areas of the Airport. There is no requirement for blast containment receptacles in either restroom.

2. Question: When will the architectural interior finishes divisions of the specifications be posted to the website? The only divisions currently posted do not have the information that I need to submit a responsive bid for the ceramic tile work.

Response: The architectural specifications are on the architectural drawings. Tile specifications can be found on sheet AR-04 under section named "Tile" and sheet AR-21 & 22, in the "Finish Schedule and Finish Specification" sections. Also, your attention is directed to the General Notes on sheet AR-02.
