Michael D. Epstein Appointed to Board of Directors of the Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority has announced the appointment of Michael David Epstein of Potomac, Maryland to its Board of Directors. Governor Robert Erhlich appointed Mr. Epstein to a term that will run through November of 2010.

Mr. Epstein is the President of Sensormatic Security Corporation and a Partner in BECO Management, a company which owns and manages 3 million square feet of commercial and medical building space in Northern Virginia, suburban Maryland and metropolitan Baltimore. He also serves as Chairman of USSI, a large regional janitorial service company.

He was recently appointed to the Maryland Economic Development Commission by Governor Erhlich and is the Chairman of the National Gaucher Foundation, a non-profit organization which funds research and does patient advocacy for Gaucher Disease. He also serves on the Board of Directors of the Republican Jewish Coalition and is Vice Chairman of its Legislative Affairs Committee. Mr. Epstein is also active in several other organizations.

Mr. Epstein will fill the position which was previously held by Norman M. Glasgow, Jr. who had served on the Board of Directors since 1993.

The Airports Authority is governed by a 13-person Board of Directors whose members are appointed by the Governors of Virginia and Maryland, the Mayor of the District of Columbia and the President of the United States. The Airports Authority operates Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport and Washington Dulles International Airport.

Together, these two airports served nearly 45 million passengers in the year 2005.
