Airports Authority Board Elects 2008 Officers

The Metropolitan Washington Airports Authority Board of Directors has elected the Honorable H.R. Crawford, Chairman, Charles D. Snelling, Vice Chairman and Philip Sunderland, Secretary.

Mr. Crawford, who has served previously on the Board as Vice Chairman and Chairman of the Business Administration Committee, is the President of Crawford Edgewood Managers, Inc., a real estate firm that develops and manages residential properties throughout the District of Columbia.

He has served as Assistant Secretary of Housing and Urban Development from 1973-1976 and was President and Chairman of the Greater Washington Council of Governments from 1977-1979. He represented Ward 7 in the District as a member of the Council of the District of Columbia from 1980-1992.

Charles D. Snelling, who was elected Vice Chairman, has previously served as Chairman of the Board's Planning and Construction Committee.

Mr. Snelling is an inventor, the holder of 18 patents, a venture capitalist, a real estate developer and an independent businessman. He has founded a number of businesses, most of them high-tech. He now serves on the boards of Cedar Crest College, the Athenaeum of Philadelphia, the Pennsylvania Society, and the National Museum of Industrial History, and is a member of the Republican State Committee of Pennsylvania. He has served on many other boards, including the Allentown City Council, the Allentown Art Museum, the Lehigh Valley Hospital, the Lehigh Valley International Airport, and the Lehigh Valley United Way.

The 13-person Board of Directors members are appointed by the Governors of Virginia and Maryland, The Mayor of the District of Columbia and the President of the United States.
